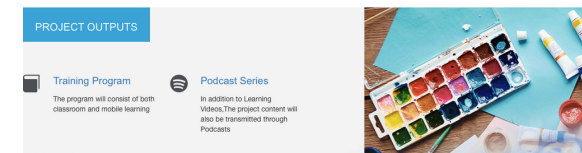
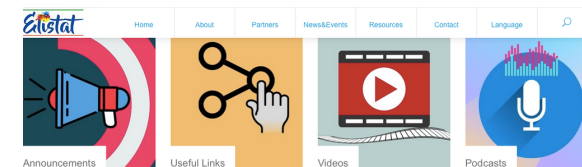
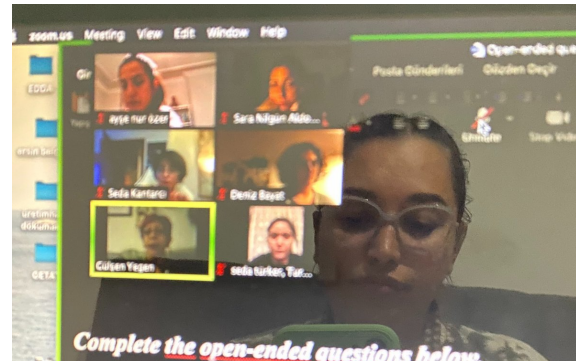
#### Focus groups
